

Confined Space Awareness

The Confined Space Awareness training will provide the participants information for understanding the potential hazards of entering & working in confined space and use of necessary controls to ensure their safety during the work. It will also provide understanding of the administrative process to plan for work and rescue in a confined space.

- Permit requirement for entry to confined spaces
- Employer and employee duties, general & confined space specific
- Hazards related to confined space and associated work activity
- Roles of Entry Supervisor, Attendant, Entrant and Rescue personnel

- Emergency work related to CS and exemptions
- Additional training requirements

This training program complies to the relevant legislation and applies the principles & standards laid out in the respective CSA standard and MoLITSD guidelines.

Ont. Reg. 632/05 defines a **confined space** as a fully or partially enclosed space;

- a. that is not both designed and constructed for continuous human occupancy, and
- b. in which atmospheric hazards may occur because of its construction, location, contents or because of work that is done in it.

The CSA standard Z1006-16, provides standards for Management of work in confined spaces & the safety of the workers.

The MoLITSD guidelines on CS help better understand the provision of implementation of the Confined Spaces Regulation O. Reg. 632/05.
